Note From The Principal

As the first semester comes to an end, I encourage all parents/ guardians to review their students academic records and review with your student their goals. The counseling office is available to assist in transcript reviews.

With the conclusion of the first semester our students have recently completed their benchmark test. These tests are used to prepare for several academic support programs. The first is our Extended Day Program which is designed to offer remediation on TAKS objectives for each of the four tested subjects. Benchmark scores are used to identify those students that need to attend. Extended day will be after school until 6:30. Parents and students will be notified in advance if their student is required to attend.

The second program is our TAKS camp. TAKS camp is a program that is offered during the school day. It is an incentive program for those students that have performed well on their benchmark test. Seniors who qualify may receive an early release ticket for those days. Parents will receive a call informing them if their child qualifies for this incentive.

We were very proud of the efforts of all of our students and look forward to continued success the rest of the year.

TAKS Assessments

You will find our annual TEA School Report Card enclosed in this mailing. Each year we are required to send this report home for parents to review. The report is based on TAKS scores from 9, 10 and Exit Level tests from last school year. We are very pleased with our academic progress.

Also included in this mailing is a copy of your student's benchmark results. Please review these results with your student. If you have questions about the results please contact your students teacher.
